## Good News!

# Special Supplemental Benefit Based on the 2005 and 2020 Plan Years

Over the past few years, the Trustees have increased the accrual rate for Plan Years ending 2021 and 2022, and just recently 2023, from 1.0% to 1.5% — a 50% increase in the benefits you have earned in those years.

Now, because of the Plan's healthy financial status, they have been able to approve *a special supplemental benefit*. This time, eligible participants will receive a special supplemental benefit as of July 1, 2023 based upon contributions received during the Plan Years ending 2005 and 2020.

	Special supplemental benefit credited July 1, 2023:	Based on Employer Contributions received for hours worked during:
New!	0.5% benefit accrual rate	Plan Year 2005 (July 1, 2004 – June 30, 2005)
New!	<b>0.5%</b> benefit accrual rate, up to the maximum \$3.50 hourly rate	Plan Year 2020 (July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2020)

If you are eligible, you will see this additional benefit, as applicable, reflected on your next annual statement.

### Who Is Eligible for the Supplemental Benefit?

Participants who are not retired (as of July 1, 2023) and had at least 500 Hours of Service\* in each of the 3 Plan years ending in 2021, 2022 and 2023 are eligible for the supplemental benefit.

Surviving spouses who, on or after July 1, 2023, are entitled to or receiving a lifetime pension through the preretirement death benefit are also eligible for the supplemental benefit. Those who receive a pre-retirement death benefit as 60 or 120 monthly payments are not eligible.

In general, retirees and beneficiaries whose benefits were effective on or before July 1, 2023 are also eligible for the supplemental benefit. They are receiving a letter with the details that apply to them.

\*Hours of Service as defined in the Plan Document and reported to this Plan including qualifying reciprocity hours and certain periods of absence, hours reported to a Cooperating Fund, and/or hours worked for a county or state building trades association or the International Ironworkers Union or its affiliates

#### **Looking Ahead**

The Trustees will continue to make decisions with a goal of providing meaningful benefits without taking undue risk, so that you can have a secure and dignified retirement.
